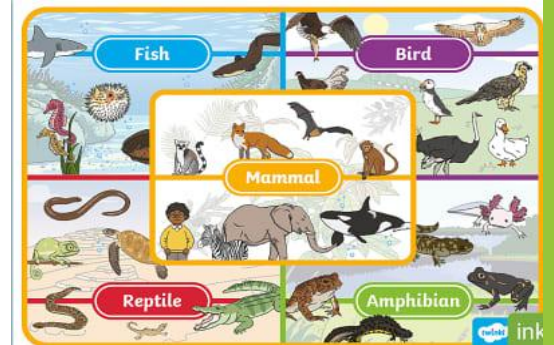
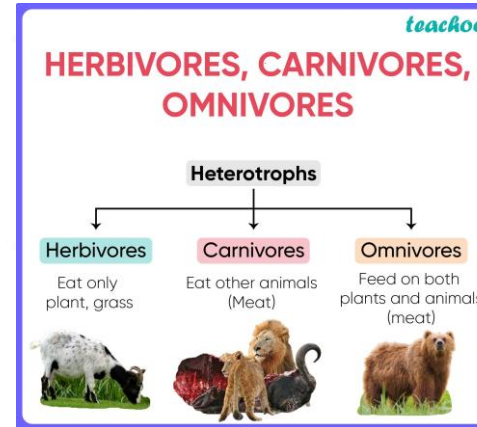
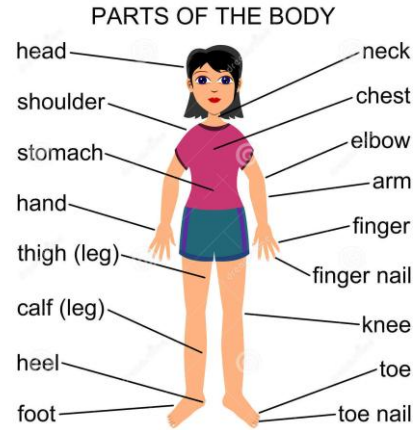


Animals, Including humans - Year 1
