Monarch	A monarch is a head of state – the formal leader of a country – who has inherited their position, such as a king or queen.
Rule	To be in charge
Reign	the time a monarch rules a country
King	A man who rules the country
Queen	A lady that rules the country
Coronation	A very special ceremony where a new king or queen officially takes their place as ruler.
